Subject: DTES Street market update: Temporary closure during relocation

Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

This email is to update you that we will have a temporary closure of the DTES Street Market this week.

As you know from previous updates, staff are working with the operator (and with the support of BC Housing) to relocate the market from a temporary site at 62 E. Hastings to another temporary site at 26 E. Hastings.

Staff were anticipating moving the market to 26 E. Hastings for tomorrow, however have just been informed that some of the site work will not be completed until later this week. Given the market needs to be off of 62 E Hastings today, this means the market will be closed for the next few days and will be able to open again at 26 E. Hastings by either Thursday, but more likely Friday of this week.
