Good afternoon Mayor and Council,

We are aware you are receiving many contacts from the public regarding about planned upgrades on the Central Valley Greenway. I can confirm that staff are developing more fulsome responses to the correspondence received. This email provides some preliminary information in the meantime.

In an effort to advance rapid-implementation improvements to the Central Valley Greenway, and building off of rapid-implementation funding from TransLink, staff scoped a number of changes to the greenway and sent a letter out to impacted residents and businesses which outlined potential changes in order to receive feedback and understand impacts.

Staff have heard a couple key concerns through the process, particularly the potential closure of the Lakewood bridge over the Grandview Cut and truck access to some industrial businesses near Clark. Staff are reviewing these and will update the proposal accordingly. Some changes, such as the Lakewood closure, may require additional engagement to further understand trade-offs in order to make a decision on how to proceed.

Staff are engaging with those residents who have raised concerns and will continue to update Council as the project progresses.
