Subject: Alberta St/W Broadway - collision risk

Good morning Mayor and Council,

I am writing to provide an update on the above matter as a subject of concern regarding an imminent public safety risk. Specifically, staff were advised of three serious collisions within the past week at the intersection of Alberta St and West Broadway. On review, the behaviour of drivers travelling southbound on Alberta St across Broadway appears to have been a significant factor.

This intersection falls within the area that is under the control of the Broadway Subway Project (the Province and ProjectCo). Our Engineering staff contacted the Project immediately regarding this matter and has received confirmation of measures implemented yesterday to improve the safety of the intersection. As indicated in the attached photo, vehicles travelling southbound on Alberta are now required to make a right turn on W Broadway. This restriction should prevent the sort of collisions seen recently at this location. It will also preclude high volumes of traffic from using Alberta St to shortcut through the neighbourhood south of Broadway.
