PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City will be implementing safety improvements on 10th Avenue that will impact visits to health facilities near Vancouver General Hospital.

Our intent is to make 10th Avenue safer for all users once complete, with a priority for increased comfort and safety for patients in the area.

During construction, the City is encouraging people cycling through the area to use 7th or 14th Avenue as alternative routes.

We appreciate your patience as these important improvements are made.

HOW YOUR VISIT WILL BE AFFECTED

Please plan ahead to allow extra time to arrive to your appointment.

During construction on-street parking will be impacted. Vehicle traffic on 10th Avenue from Ash St to Willow St will be one-way during construction with traffic direction changing during the course of the construction period. Vehicle traffic between Oak St to Willow St will remain two-way traffic. Access to all facilities will be maintained for people of all abilities.

When you arrive, easily identifiable personnel will be on-site to help you find your destination.

- Your health facility may have reserved parking not listed on this map. Please consult with them for parking advice.
- Parking lots may be reserved for patient use only.
