Subject: Upcoming NR: Vital Community Facilities Expand Services in Downtown Vancouver

Dear Mayor and Council,

Last week the City's three community centres (Carnegie, Evelyne Saller and Gathering Place), entered phase three of operations which includes expanded programming, increased drop-in space and dine-in meal services. We will be issuing a news release about the services expansion today. The three centres have continued to provide vital services throughout the pandemic, and since they moved to phase two in July they have welcomed more than 21,000 visits to their respite spaces and served approximately 1,600 take-out meals each day. All three facilities have been inspected by public health officials and approved as having met or exceeded standards for expanding services.
