Good afternoon Dear Mayor and Council,

I am writing to update you on an incident that occurred late this afternoon at the above-referenced address. A large tree (approx. 60') situated on City property fell onto an adjacent multi-family residential building.

Fortunately, there were no injuries. However, the tree came to rest on the concrete balconies of 3 apartments. The residents of those 3 apartments have been evacuated. The attached photo provides a view of the situation at present.

VFRS and Park Board managers are presently on scene, and a Park Board forestry crew is en route to remove the tree. A building inspector has also been dispatched to assess the damage to the building.

At this time, we do not have any information as to the cause. The tree will be assessed by Forestry staff prior to removal.
