**Subject:** Water main leak - Stanley Park

Good afternoon Mayor, Councillors and Park Board Commissioners,

Further to our communication last week, I am writing with a brief update on Metro Vancouver's efforts to repair the leaking water main adjacent to the Stanley Park causeway.

Over the weekend, Metro crews excavated the site and were successful in applying measures to reduce the volume of water flowing from the breached main. The main continues to leak, but flow is controlled and dechlorinated before entering Lost Lagoon.

Metro is currently awaiting a recommendation from their engineering consultants regarding methodology for a permanent repair. They have expressed confidence that they will be able to complete a repair without affecting COV service levels and without further impacts to causeway traffic.
