**Subject:** Storm response - update

Good afternoon Mayor and Councillors,

Further to my note late yesterday, I can advise that the most recent weather forecasts for the next 72 hours call for somewhat less extreme conditions than had been predicted previously. Nevertheless, Environment Canada is calling for winds of 70-100 km/h in Georgia Strait and up to 70 mm of rain overnight tonight and into Friday morning. The forecast for Saturday has also improved although, again, heavy rain and wind warnings remain in effect.

Our operating departments have crews on stand-by to deal with storm impacts overnight tonight and our EOC will be staffed as of 6:30 am Friday morning. We will continue to monitor our resource levels and will adjust as appropriate based on actual weather conditions and consequences.
