Greetings Mayor and Council-

The following is a status update on the fire at 160 E. Hastings. The event is fluid at the moment as investigations are still underway to determine the status of units.

Status of Evacuees:

- Evacuees who accepted support were lodged at Evelyne Saller last night and provided breakfast this morning
- Evacuees will be relocated to **Roddan Lodge** today with support from CS. Approximately 20 people will be housed here unless they opt to go elsewhere (ie: find shelter with friends or another location)
- Roddan Lodge will be undergoing renovations and this is why there is space available here.

Status of 160 E. Hastings (Regent):

- As of last night, residents of floors 3 and up were able to return to their units
- Staff are working with VFRS on site to get a report on damage and an estimate of return time for residents of the first 2 floors.

I will keep you posted as the situation evolves.
