Greetings Mayor and Council-

As we had expected, the snow has arrived. There isn't enough to plow yet, but it is expected to continue mostly steady through 10am. Potential for slushy roads, accumulation up to 10am this morning. Rain and wet snow showers increasing this morning then tapering off with mostly dry conditions.

Here's our current response:

- Fourteen salters, salting main routes
- Two Kubota salting/brining priority bike routes
- Two Jitney salting/brining shared bike routes
- Four Salters, salting priority hills, and water leaks
- Operations has dispatched all Streets crews to pre-planned areas for removal of snow at Bus Shelters, Gutters that lead to catch basins, and sidewalk let downs at intersections.
 - Bridge Crew Bombardiers clearing seawall paths, and sidewalks.
