Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am writing in response to your request received on June 20, 2016 for:

A dataset containing the locations of parking related signage such as 2 hour parking permitted, except with permit, except for residents, etc.

According to Parking Management, there is no dataset with parking related signage, but there are maps of residential neighbourhoods that show these regulations (albeit in a less precise way than exact sign locations) available here: <http://vancouver.ca/streets-transportation/permit-fees-and-zones.aspx>

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request.
