Dear CMT,

I am pleased to announce the appointment of two new Directors in Development, Buildings and Licensing (DBL).

First, **Kathryn Kolbuch Holm** will serve as the **Chief Licence Inspector and Director of Licensing, Property Use, and Animal Services**, replacing Andreea Toma who left this position at the end of 2016. Kathryn joins DBL from Engineering, where she was the Senior Branch Head of Streets & Electrical Design since 2013. Prior to that, she was a Manager in the Business Planning Secretariat (now called Business Planning and Project Support (BPPS)) where she was, among other things, the project manager for the evaluation, planning and contract negotiation phase of Vancouver's Public Bike Share system. Her key priorities for this year will include updating policies for Short Term Rentals, Ridesharing, Liquor, and Medical Marijuana as well as a major effort to rationalize and improve the current licensing regime. She will also lead a strategic planning exercise with Animal Services and will play a pivotal role in shaping and implementing our new proactive enforcement activities.

Next, **Mark Greenfield** will join the team as the new **Director of Strategic Operations, Planning, and Program Management**. Mark comes to the City from BC Hydro where he has served as Senior Manager of Performance & Process for the past three years. Prior to BC Hydro, Mark served in a number of relevant positions in both Vancouver and the United Kingdom, including Manager of Operations at the RCMP in Surrey and Manager of Strategic Planning & Operations at Network Rail in London, England. In this new role, Mark will be responsible for a diverse portfolio of work, including Corporate process implementation, DBL metrics and reporting, POSSE system and process transformation, and special projects such as the next phase of our Seismic efforts and the proactive enforcement initiative. Mark will start on March 6<sup>th</sup>.

I'm thrilled to welcome Kathryn and Mark to the DBL senior leadership team and look forward to the thought-leadership, strong management, and fresh perspectives that they will bring to the department.
