Greetings Mayor and Council,

I am writing to provide you with an update on the Housing Policy Team's move from Community Services to Planning Urban Design and Sustainability, which was announced on March 30.

The team of five - Edna Cho, Matthew Bourke, Allison Dunnet, Sarah Ellis, and Aaron Cheng - have now moved from Woodward's to the 2nd Floor West Annex Building and been settling in over the last two weeks. In addition to the staff who moved over, the team is actively recruiting for two additional positions as well as an Assistant Director to lead the group. In the interim, Edna Cho is leading the group and reporting to Randy Pecarski, Deputy Director of Planning.

This group is leading the completion of the 10-year "Housing Vancouver" strategy. The move will help to further integrate housing policy and Land Use planning work. It will help propel many policy initiatives: Rate of Change Phase II, the improvement of Tenant Relocation and Protection Policies, Empty Homes Implementation, Family Housing Design Guidelines, and Affordable Home Ownership. It will also help us give support to the Renters Advisory Committee and participate in Metro Vancouver's Housing Subcommittee.

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
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Reorganization of Housing Policy Effective April 3,2017
