Greetings Mayor and Council,

As you are aware, the City has received information that on Saturday, August 19 from 12-4 pm, an anti-immigration protest and a counter protest will take place in the vicinity of City Hall. We anticipate that the two combined events will create a large crowd in the area.

As a precautionary measure, there will be an increased security presence at City Hall and we have advised staff not to work from the building this Saturday. If you do need to enter City Hall during this time, please ensure you have your City-issued ID card on you at all times and enter the building via the CityLearn entrance on the sub-ground level. If you need assistance on the day, please contact Corporate Security at 604-873-7157.

As well as restricting access to City Hall, there will also be no parking allowed on the upper deck, Council parking lot and on Cambie and Yukon from 10 pm on Friday, August 18 to late on Saturday, August 19. If you have a vehicle parked in this area, please ensure it is removed prior to Saturday morning or it will be subject to towing.
