- Carey Newman's *Witness Blanket* (a full size replica), inspired by a woven blanket, the large-scale art installation is made out of hundreds of items reclaimed from Residential Schools, churches, government buildings, etc.
- Weavers Corner, an interactive space to learn more about the craft of weaving from multiple cultural perspectives
- Kairos Blanket Exercise, a 1.5 hr interactive workshop teaching Indigenous rights history
- Lacrosse demos and drills
- Commitment Gallery
