

This memo invites Mayor and Council and Park Board Commissioners to upcoming public engagement opportunities for the Arbutus Greenway. Between October 27 and November 4, the public is invited to learn more about the greenway and provide feedback on emerging designs, including the proposed location of a future streetcar.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Arbutus Greenway is a future, north-south transportation corridor that will connect people, parks, and communities from False Creek to the Fraser River. In early 2017, we consulted with the public on vision and values for the future greenway. Over the summer, the design team has been working on potential alignments for the transportation components of the project, including walking, cycling, and a future streetcar.



## DISCUSSION

Over 300 people applied to be an Arbutus Champion for the Design Jam. We selected the 100 successful Arbutus Champions using a stratified random sample based on location, age, and gender, with the goal of having representation from across the City and from all age groups.

Between October 27 and November 4, there will be multiple opportunities for the public to provide input on the design for the future greenway. These include:
