SUBJECT : Tree Removal - West 10th Avenue

Dear Mayor and Council,

The Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation is responsible for tree maintenance on City property. Although every effort is taken to retain viable trees through proper arboriculture practices, at some point it may become necessary to remove and replace them with new trees. Our Urban Forestry Supervisor, Amit Gandha, has determined that six (6) trees located on West 10th Avenue, between Cambie and Willow Streets, must be removed and replaced.

These six (6) trees in question are either dead or hazardous to public safety. We cannot commit to retaining the trees without risk to the public or property.

When a tree is removed, there is always an aesthetic impact to the block. Fortunately, these blocks are already lined with a number of larger trees. Therefore the visual impact will be minimized because of the remaining trees' overarching canopies. Tree canopy loss will also be minimized as the other trees will take over the space temporarily, until the new trees mature and fill in the space.

Removal of the trees will be coordinated with the Traffic Management Group and the West 10th Improvement Project to avoid any delays. We also will schedule the removals over a period of 3 weeks, starting December 11, 2017, in order to minimize impact to patients requiring access to the medical facilities along West 10th Avenue. We do not want to close down several blocks at a time in this area.

Urban Forestry will post notifications at each tree to inform the public and provide a contact number to answer any questions or concerns.
