Subject: Follow-up to Question on Non-Vancouver Residents

Greetings Mayor and Council,

To address Councillor Bremner's question on Tuesday about the number of non-Vancouver residents who have negative police contacts. I would like to share the answer provided by Chief Adam Palmer:

- For persons where we considered criminal charges (persons coded as: charged, charge recommended, or chargeable) then 31% of persons are non-Vancouver residents.
- When we look at violation tickets (e.g. Provincial Motor Vehicle Act offences) the majority of persons (56%) are non-Vancouver residents.
- Both percentages are based on 2016 full-year data.
