**Subject:** Millennium Line Extension Open Houses

Greetings Mayor and Council

On March 10 and 14, the City will be hosting open houses at our new CityLab space (511 W Broadway/Crossroads building) to share and solicit feedback on our draft City principles and strategies for design and construction mitigation strategies for the future construction of the Millennium Line Broadway Extension (aka the Broadway Subway).

The sessions will be drop-in style and provide the public an opportunity to provide City-specific feedback that the City will then use to guide its discussions with TransLink. TransLink staff will be present at the event to answer larger 10-year Investment Plan questions and provide their perspectives on our principles and strategies.

The feedback received at these sessions will help to refine the principles and strategies that will be brought to Council in May for approval. The Council-approved principles and strategies will guide City staff input to the project, most immediately in developing the Master Agreement with TransLink that will outline project roles and responsibilities.
