At approximately 8:00, two City of Vancouver District Building Inspectors responded to reports of a window falling from a building in the vicinity of the Landmark Hotel on Robson Street, which is currently being demolished. On arriving, the inspectors were able to determine that the window fell from a residential building across the street from the Landmark Hotel. The inspectors agree that this is a 'one-off' incident and are not concerned about the remaining windows or the condition of the building.
