The public are being invited to visit our City Lab at 511 West Broadway (first floor, Crossroads Building) this weekend to provide their input on the types of infrastructure and assets that are important to them.

We will be engaging in further public engagement activities to solicit input on the draft plan, including using an online ideation platform, once that has been developed and shared with Council.
