Subject: Overturned tugboat - final update

Good morning Mayor and Council,

I am pleased to advise that the tugboat was removed from the water last night with no further fuel spillage. The contaminated water inside the tug was pumped into a sealed containment vessel and the boat has been transported to dry dock for repairs.

CoV and Park Board staff conducted a shoreline assessment of Fraser River Park this morning and did not observe any contamination. The beach at Fraser River Park is now open for public access. However, environmental monitoring will continue on the south side of the river for the next few days as there is still a noticeable oil sheen in some areas.
