**Subject:** Upcoming news release: City to install additional 140+ curb ramps

Dear Mayor and Council,

Starting this September, the City will install approximately 140 additional curb ramps throughout Vancouver to improve sidewalk access for people walking to transit.

Supported by TransLink's Walking Infrastructure to Transit funding program, this year's installations are in addition to the 100 – 200 curb ramps that are typically installed annually as part of the City's regular capital program and development projects. The new ramps will fill gaps in the existing sidewalk network and include locations previously requested by the public. Installations are scheduled to be complete by December 2018.

The news release regarding this matter will be issued tomorrow.
