Dear Mayor and Council,

On Friday, September 7th from 2 pm to 7 pm, and Saturday, September 8^h from 11 am to 4 pm, staff will open the temporary modular housing at 2132 Ash Street to the public to see the new homes that will support 52 people who were experiencing homelessness.

The public tour will provide an opportunity for the community to see what the inside of the building looks like and learn more about the services that are provided as part of supportive housing. Staff will be on site to answer general questions about the project and provide further information.

To date, more than 600 new temporary modular homes are at various stages of the development and approval process with more than 200 already tenanted.
