At council on Tuesday you requested information on the allocation of the opioid tax. Here's how it was allocated:

2017 Budget	Opioid Response Initiatives
2,050,000	new three-person medic unit in the Downtown Eastside and a mental health coordinator to support firefighters
430,000	new Community Policing Centre (CPC) in Strathcona and additional funding for other CPCs across the city
1,020,000	23 high-impact community overdose response grants
3,500,000	

2018 Budget	Opioid Response Initiatives
2,400,000	Permanent funding for the three-person medic unit in Vancouver Fire and Rescue Services and VPD Community Policing Centres
700,000	VPD Drug Containment Facility for safe and proper handling, and processing of drug exhibits
300,000	Opioid crisis response
200,000	Micro Cleaning Grants in the Downtown Eastside
3,600,000
