RE: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of June 17, 2018 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

All correspondence between bubble tea shops/suppliers of bubble tea shops and the City of Vancouver that reference to the City's intention to ban single-use items like plastic straws from March 1, 2018 to June 17, 2018.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located.

Please note: Searches were conducted with the individual Councillors as well as staff from the Zero Waste & Resource Recovery Division, who produced the Council Report "Single-Use Item Reduction Strategy" which went to Council on May 16, 2018 regarding banning plastic straws.
