RE: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of September 2, 2018 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Regarding the "All the Trees" program, under the City-funded Artists in Communities program, that encourages people to send email to select trees that are tagged with ID numbers. Request is for a copy of all email received by each "tree" under the program, a copy of the standard response and a copy of any individual or unique responses, since the beginning of the program.

As per the Community Art Residency Agreement, the Artist owns the work (i.e. the emails and the responses) and holds all copyright until December 31, 2018. To date, there are no records in the care and custody of the Vancouver Park Board or the City of Vancouver until the contract is complete.

Under section 52 of the Act, and within 30 business days of receipt of this letter, you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your FOI request by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc.bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.
