The records track amounts budgeted for projects, and do not track final accounting figures. The budget amounts are not adjusted for inflation. Some of the entries found in the registry are missing information due to a number of factors: the age of the artwork, whether or not the artwork was commissioned by the Public Art Program, whether the project was managed by another department (i.e. Engineering, Park Board), or by a private developer.
