SUBJECT: Bus Reroutes for Broadway Subway Construction

During the construction of the Broadway Subway, there will be significant construction activity in the blocks where transit stations will be located. The #9 and #99 buses will continue to operate on Broadway, but all other bus routes that currently only use Broadway for a portion of their route between Main Street and Arbutus Street will be rerouted to adjacent streets. The routes that will require changes are the #14, #16 and #17, which are all currently operating as trolley routes. These bus routes currently carry a combined total of approximately 50,000 passengers per day. City staff worked with TransLink staff to assess potential options for these reroutes. The review included looking at both technology and alignment options.

The technology review explored various battery options that were not selected due to costs of retrofitting buses and concerns over the battery life not lasting the required five year duration of the reroute.




Figure 1: Bus Route Changes for Broadway Subway Construction

Exploration of alignment options resulted in the proposed changes as outlined in Figure 1 below. These were the only acceptable options that provided service as close as possible to the existing routes and minimized trolley infrastructure construction.

To facilitate the rerouting of bus services, the Province will install new trolley infrastructure on MacDonald Street, Ash Street, West 6th Avenue and West 12th Avenue.

The new reroutes and trolley infrastructure will:

- Remove bus routes that use parts of Broadway and will be affected by Broadway Subway construction for a portion of their route. This will improve the reliability of all bus routes.
- Minimize the use of diesel buses, resulting in reduced costs, noise and emissions.
- Ensure that buses can continue to provide access to major destinations, including Vancouver General Hospital.
- Provide future flexibility for the trolley network.

These changes will come into effect starting in 2020 and continue on through 2025 when construction is anticipated to be completed. We plan on starting construction on these reroutes early this year and will be notifying residents in advance.

Towards the end of the construction of the Broadway Subway Project, consultation will take place on the final transit service plan that will be implemented after the Subway is open. Staff will report back to Council on the proposed changes and results of this public consultation.
