Quick update:

The work on this is ongoing. Booms were set up in the inlet to catch debris and oil from the piles that were washed into the water. It's still not clear whose pipe it is that caused the problems, but the valves were mostly shut off so that there is only a small amount of water leaking out to prevent back flow. Right now the situation is under control.
