Subject: Upcoming IB - Nanaimo St upgrades

Greetings Mayor and Council,

On Monday, February 4 the City will begin construction to upgrade critical sewer infrastructure along Nanaimo Street between McGill Street and East 4th Avenue. Work is anticipated for completion in spring 2020, and at least one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained throughout construction.

In coordination with these sewer upgrades, there's also an opportunity to improve Nanaimo Street to make it safer and more comfortable for all road users. Staff are currently reviewing feedback from the community collected at the open house, through the online survey, and by email, to determine the scope of this work in coordination with the sewer separation. We will share what they heard from the community at the end of February.

The news release will be distributed tomorrow.
