Good Morning Mayor and Council

Our crews were out in force yesterday applying the anti-icing agents on the streets with the expectation of seeing snow today.

Parts of Vancouver have seen light flurries this morning, but accumulations not expected until late afternoon.

When we see signs that is an actual snow event, the National Yards DOC will be activated. In the meantime the Streets crews from Engineering will continue to monitor weather [through 7pm](#). We will activate if conditions change (ie snow accumulations).

Sanitation scheduled to relieve as Storm Lead [at 7pm](#) through overnight.

As pretty as the snow can be, it's extremely expensive to deal with, so we'll be watching our contingency funds drop as the snow falls. Ah well, I can never really enjoy a good snow storm anymore for that reason.
