Further to the update that Sadhu provided yesterday evening, I can advise that Engineering, VFRS and VPD attended Oppenheimer Park again this morning with the objective of assessing compliance with safety requirements set out in the recent Fire Chief's Order. Based on the inspection by VFRS, the team removed a number of articles that were inconsistent with the Order, including gasoline, propane tanks and gas generators, along with other abandoned property and debris.

Staff also removed 4 tents that clearly have not been occupied. However, none of the individuals camping in the park were asked to leave or to move their tents.
