**Subject:** Upcoming NR - Short Term Rentals

Greetings Mayor and Council,

The City's short-term rental regulations have been in effect for six months and the program has been making steady progress towards educating the public about the need for a business licences in order to operate, and enforcing against operators who are not complying with the regulations.

Since September 1, 2018, the City's enforcement team has opened more than 2,000 case files and taken enforcement action against 820 suspected unauthorized short-term rental properties. Over 2,600 business licences have been issued for 2019.
