I am very excited to share the results of the [Period Promise campaign](#). In just over a week City staff raised an incredible 16,238 products – which will go directly to vulnerable people in need within our community.

We had 25 different Period Promise boxes over various City work locations accepting donations and were able to increase our donations significantly from last year. Over the coming weeks, the products will be distributed to local community agencies. Thanks to you, vulnerable people in need of menstruation products will have greater access to the supplies they need.
