In the coming weeks, the BC Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI) will announce the shortlist of qualified candidate teams that will be invited to participate in the Request for Proposals (RFP) process for the design, construction and financing of the Broadway Subway.

The Broadway Subway project request for qualifications (RFQ) was posted to BC Bid in February 2019. The RFQ was the first step in identifying a contractor to design, build and finance the Broadway Subway project. The RFQ closed on April 17, 2019 and submissions have been evaluated. The City's Rapid Transit Office provided two staff who participated as members of the submission evaluation team. These two staff have signed non-disclosure agreements and are unable to provide any additional details at this time.

Based on these evaluations, MOTI will select up to three candidate teams to participate in the subsequent RFP phase of the competitive selection process.
