Subject: INVITATION - Eid al-Adha Celebration @ City Hall - August 1, 2019

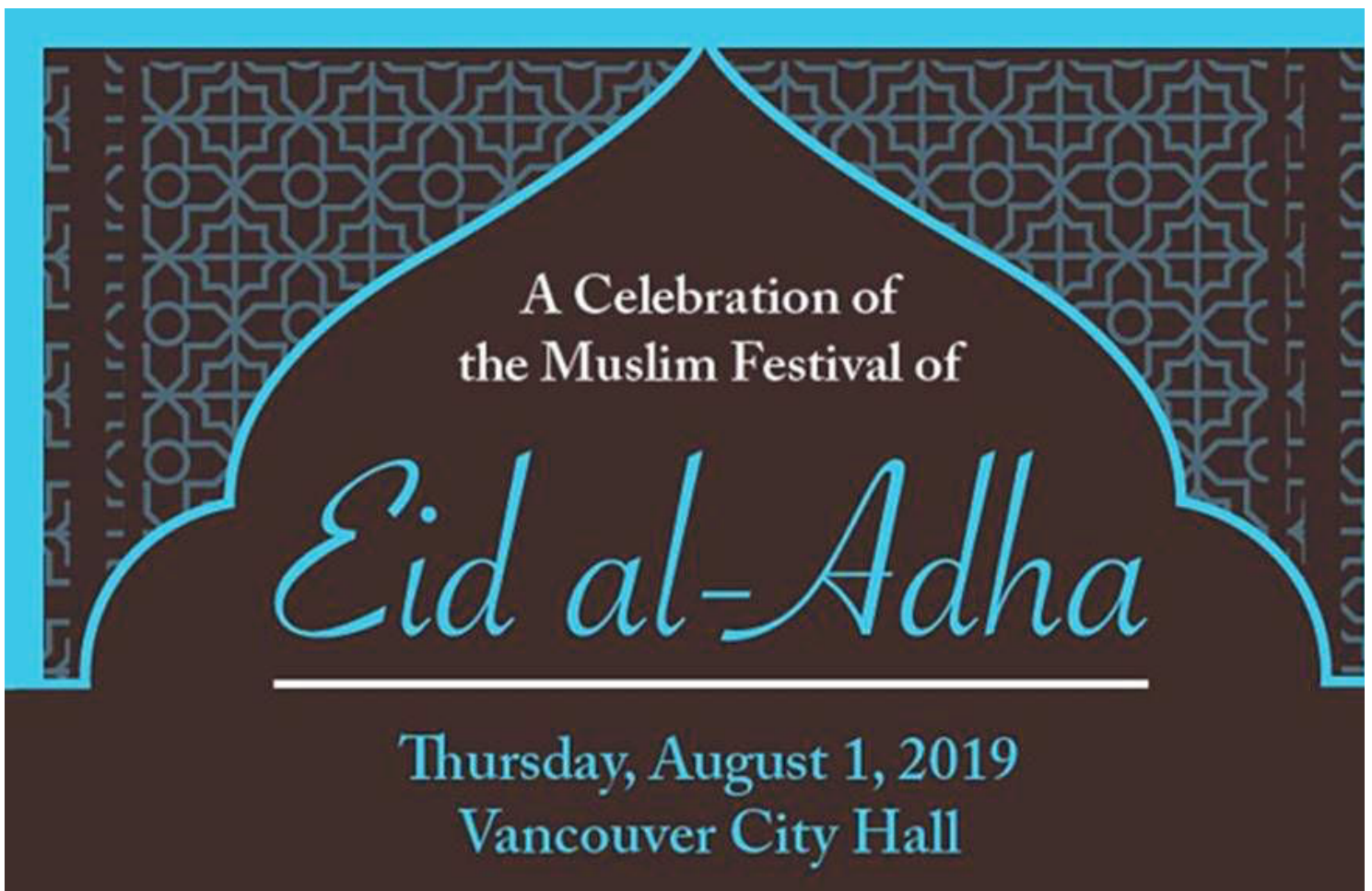
Dear Mayor and Council,

Eid al-Adha is a Muslim celebration which links Islamic history with the history of Islam, Judaism, and Christianity through their common Abrahamic heritage. The festival marks the completion of the Hajj, which is the annual pilgrimage to Mecca. Over 1.4 billion Muslims around the world, including 7 million in North America and 100,000 in British Columbia celebrate the festival of Eid al-Adha.
