Greetings Mayor and Council:

Approximately 2 dozen people from the "Our Homes Can't Wait" group are gathered on the North Lawn behind City Hall. They are planning to hold a demonstration including speeches, banners, and snacks for those involved. Their protest is calling for the City to support the tent city in Oppenheimer Park.

Some of the protesters said they plan to engage Mayor and City Councillors when they exit the building to their vehicles in the Councillors' Parking Lot. If Councillors need an escort to their vehicle they should call Security at 604-873-7157. No structures or tents are visible at this time and the protesters have been advised this will not be allowed. Plainclothes VPD are in the area and Corporate Protective Services staff are monitoring the demonstration.
