Greetings Mayor and Council,

We are looking forward to working with you on the launch of the City-wide planning effort on November 14th.

When: 9am-1pm November 14th

Where: Beginning at City Hall in the media briefing room and then travelling to community sites.

What: Food, conversation and connection with those who live, work and play in Vancouver.

Why these sites: They are dispersed across Vancouver and represent places where diverse types of people tend to gather on a Thursday morning – people who might not otherwise attend a session hosted by the City.

- As discussed, we would like to support you to travel to a site around the City among those proposed here (as well as any you like to suggest).
- We will prepare a dialogue event that will allow you to listen and connect with community members or other constituents at each site.
- We will use the questions we are asking as a jumping off point, but encourage you to ask and listen as you choose.
- We are reaching out to elected leaders from Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh to seek involvement.
- We will be pitching mainstream and social media journalists to have them follow you through the morning. A facilitator and a communications staff person will both be supporting you and helping set up at each site, and ensure it runs smoothly.
- In advance of the 14th, we will sit down with each of you and brief you on the morning's events and how we can support the dialogue.
