Subject: Upcoming MA - Parking Overnight Campaign Launch

Dear Mayor and Council,

On December 12, the City will be hosting a media event at a downtown EasyPark lot, together with MADD Canada, Preventable, EasyPark and the VPD, to launch its Park Overnight Awareness Campaign. Via a social media campaign and across 35 busy EasyPark lots we will be encouraging individuals to plan ahead to leave their car parked overnight to avoid driving impaired.

Using popular parking apps (PayByPhone, EasyPark, HonkMobile) or on-site pay stations and attendants, drivers can plan their parking before a night out or, if needed, have a backup plan if they've had too much. In most City-owned lots, residents can have peace of mind by extending their parking overnight until 6pm the next day. At most of the City's on-street parking, cars can be parked until 11am the next day.
