2. **Any briefing or information documents that the Mayor or Council has received from staff or other levels of government regarding changes to the Port of Vancouver since October 2018.**

Please note that the Mayor had two meetings that were responsive to the request:

- 1) Meeting with Transportation Minister on November 8, 2018;
- 2) Meeting with Port Metro Vancouver (Robin Silvester) on March 26, 2019.

Under section 52 of the Act you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your request. The Act allows you 30 business days from the date you receive this notice to request a review by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc.bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.

If you request a review, please provide the Commissioner's office with: 1) the request number assigned to your request (#04-1000-20-2019-321); 2) a copy of this letter; 3) a copy of your original request for information sent to the City of Vancouver; and 4) detailed reasons or grounds on which you are seeking the review.


