I have received your fax of April 30, 1998 outlining your proposed remediation for the underground storage tank at 455 Abbott Street. Further to discussions with both Messrs. Bill Moloney and Doug Roberts, this fax is to advise you that your proposed remediation method is acceptable to the City. Given the low mobility of bunker oil, depth of storage tank, and physical site constraints from existing utilities, your proposal to pump out the contents of the tank and fill it with concrete is acceptable. 455 Abbott Street, Vancouver - Underground Storage Tank

As seen on the attached City of Vancouver information, there is an unused UST located at the above property, which has been the subject of recent investigation by D.Kelly Environmental.

The UST is located (approximately) half under the sidewalk and half under the road surface, at an estimated depth of 4 metres below road surface, to the top of the tank. We have been able to locate the supply pipe (which fed the boiler) within the basement of the building and confirmed that the UST contains bunker oil and probably water.

The tank was last used in the 1970s (prior to changeover to district heat) and does not appear to have been pumped out at that time. There is some evidence of leakage of bunker oil from the installation.

Given the above details, we would like to obtain agreement from the City of Vancouver that the following measures would be acceptable, subject to obtaining a permit from the Fire Department:


- Pumping out the contents of the UST;
- Steam cleaning the inside of the UST; and
- Filling the UST with weak concrete.



CHECKED JUNE 21 2001 STRANGE ABBOTT ST APPROVED ASS ABBOTT ST Grease Interceptor Size for Existing Kitchen on Main Floor of Heritage House, 455 Re:_ Abbott Street

We have been requested to specify a grease interceptor for the existing kitchen on this project. All fixtures that can discharge grease into the sanitary system must be connected through a grease interceptor. On this project there are no floor drains in the kitchen and only one pot sink. The pot sink is therefore the only required fixture that must discharge into the grease interceptor.

The minimum size required by the GVRD for grease interceptors is 50 gpm. Either a low profile, under sink type grease interceptor could be used or a normal style grease interceptor installed under the floor could be used. Grease interceptors must be installed close to the fixtures they are collecting and must be accessible for regular maintenance. Please find attached shop drawings for three acceptable models (all units must be model 800's capable of 50 gpm). The plumbing contractor can select one of the three units as appropriate for the application and in coordination with Mark James Group.
