RE: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of June 10, 2019 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

- 1. Number of Kitsilano South parking permits that have been issued by the City to vehicles associated to the 2000 block of Stephens Street; and
- 2. Number of permit parking spots that exist in the 2000 block of Stephens Street.

Date Range: January 1; 2018 to June 10, 2019.

The City's Transportation Division has provided us with a response to your above request:

- Within the specified area and timeframe, 14 parking permits have been issued; however, only 10 permits are active as some permits have either expired or have been closed;
- 2) The City does not keep a record of the number of available spaces; however, there is approximately 24 metres of curb space on the west side of the street, and approximately 35 metres of curb space on the east side of the street dedicated to permit parking. At a distance of 6 metres per parking space, this is equivalent to approximately 10 spaces.

Under section 52 of the Act, and within 30 business days of receipt of this letter, you may ask the Information & Privacy Commissioner to review any matter related to the City's response to your FOI request by writing to: Office of the Information & Privacy Commissioner, info@oipc.bc.ca or by phoning 250-387-5629.
