Re: Request for Access to Records under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (the "Act")

I am responding to your request of June 19, 2019 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

All records (in excel format) that set out Motor Vehicle Act infraction tickets incurred by drivers of City of Vancouver vehicles in the course of their duties, from June 1, 2016 to May 31, 2019, including the following:

- 1. Any details recorded about the infraction tickets; and
- 2. Monetary penalty associated with those tickets.

The City is unable to provide responsive records for this request. Current City Policy does not require staff members to report tickets and traffic violations. The responsible department for Driver's Services notes the City's Safe Driving Policy is currently being updated to include reporting requirements.
