Hi Al, Rene:

We are in the process of mobilizing for excavation at the 528 West King Edward site. To follow our draft site plan previously discussed this summer, we now have further information specific to the excavation scope of work.

Please review the attached traffic management plan reflecting the street use that we propose. We would like to:

- 1. Have a No-Stopping / Construction Vehicles Only usage along the parking lane
- 2. Per the attached Traffic Management Plan, close the sidewalk as required for loading out of excavation materials on to King Edward. Signage and traffic control personnel will be provided.
- 3. Restrict traffic on the curb-side Eastbound travel lane during excavation only. In the future, we would only require this lane closure for concrete pours and other limited, specific activities. This is shown on the Traffic Management Plan.

The trucks hauling excavated material off the site will head to the Lafarge disposal site in Abbotsford. Trucks hauling off site will travel to southbound Cambie Street and either use the Oak Street or Knight Street bridge to exit the city limits.

Pedestrian hoarding will be constructed in early January following the removal of the excavated materials.



Traffic plan needs to swap the "Sidewalk Closed" sign at Ash with a "Sidewalk Closed Ahead" sign, and add a "Sidewalk Closed" sign immediately adjacent to the closure to preserve other properties on the block.
