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Backgrounder: Walk for Reconciliation



On September 24th, 2017, Reconciliation Canada and the City of Vancouver are hosting the Walk for Reconciliation. Similar to the first walk in 2013, the 2017 Walk will bring together tens-ofthousands of people in a shared commitment towards reconciliation, and revitalized relationships among Indigenous peoples and all Canadians. Following the Walk, participants will experience the Reconciliation Expo, a full-day of activities and entertainment highlighting the unique contributions of individuals from all backgrounds towards reconciliation in Canada.

Reconciliation builds resilient and sustainable communities by weaving together the unique and diverse strengths of people from all backgrounds. The Walk for Reconciliation is an event for people of all ages, backgrounds, cultures and faiths. Reconciliation Canada is inviting everyone to participate in the reconciliation movement.

The Walk for Reconciliation is a Canada 150+ Signature Event, and is being delivered in partnership between the City of Vancouver and Reconciliation Canada. Canada 150+ is grounded in community consultation, direction from Vancouver's Urban Aboriginal Peoples Advisory Committee (UAPAC), and permission from Vancouver's three Host Nations: The Musqueam Nation, The Squamish Nation and Tsleil-Waututh Nation.

Walk marshalling will begin outside of the Queen Elizabeth Theatre at 9 a.m. The Walk will begin at 9:30 and proceed 2km through the Georgia Viaduct towards Strathcona Park, which will be the site for the first-ever Reconciliation Expo.

The first-ever Reconciliation Expo will be a multicultural experience and an exciting opportunity for everyone to engage with local artisans, community members and other walk participants.

At the Expo, there will be community booths that will include information regarding reconciliation, experiential cultural activities, and a range of presentations from community groups, Indigenous organizations, and multicultural groups. Additionally, there will be an area dedicated to local artisans which will provide an opportunity for people to experience local Indigenous art and culture. There will also be a place for children to play educational games and a space for Indigenous craft making, as well as a variety of Vancouver based food-trucks serving ethnically-diverse foods.

On the main stage, there will be captivating performances running throughout the afternoon. These performances will include live singing, dancing and various displays of local artwork. Most notably, there will be an address from the keynote speaker, National Chief Perry Bellegarde, to inspire further work on reconciliation in our country.

This exciting and interactive event will enforce the notion that the reconciliation movement includes everyone and unites us all.

Exhibit: Site Unseen (Gitga'at and West Vancouver Youth – Mural of Merging Voices) 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

This unique and innovative project supports links between different groups of coastal youth. To deepen the understanding of their unique cultures and lands, students from the District of West Vancouver and the Gitga'at Nation in Hartley Bay worked togetherto create a large art installation that explores reconciliation among youth.

Exhibit: National Centre for Truth and Reconciliation

10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

An exhibit from the National Centre for Truth and Reconciliation that explores working together for a strong future and better understanding of reconciliation.

Exhibit: Carey Newman's Witness Blanket (Full-Size Replica)

10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Inspired by a woven blanket, the Witness Blanket is a large-scale art installation, made out of hundreds of items reclaimed from Residential Schools, churches, government buildings and traditional and cultural structures including Friendship Centres, band offices, treatment centres and universities, from across Canada. The Witness Blanket stands as a national monument to recognise the atrocities of the Indian Residential School era, honour the children, and symbolise ongoing reconciliation.

Lacrosse Demos and Drills

1 p.m. to 3 p.m. *May begin earlier

ISPARC (Indigenous Sport, Physical Activity & Recreation Council) will facilitate fun lacrosse demos and drills with BC NAIG team athletes and coaches.

Right to Play

10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Right to Play uses the transformative power of play to unlock the power and possibility in every child. Right to Play will host three stations for children at the Expo site: (1) Gardening – Participants will be asked to 'plant' their intentions for reconciliation; (2) Dreamcatchers – Workshop to create dreamcatchers that can be taken home; and (3) Facilitated Games –To engage kids in thinking about reconciliation.

Weavers Corner

1 p.m. to 3 p.m.

Facilitated by the Earthand Gleaners Society and a diverse group of Indigenous and non-Indigenous weavers, this will be a tactile, interactive space to learn more about the craft of weaving from multiple cultural perspectives. The space will be hands-on, inviting participants to engage with plants native to this territory and learn more about the social history of weaving.



Kairos Blanket Exercise

1 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.

The KAIROS Blanket Exercise is an interactive learning experience that teaches the Indigenous rights history we're rarely taught. Developed in response to the 1996 Report of the Royal Commission on Aboriginal Peoples, which recommended education on Canadian-Indigenous history as one of the key steps to reconciliation, the Blanket Exercise covers over 500 years of history.

On-site Mural Painting

11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The Vancouver Mural Festival will host an interactive mural site where with spray paint where participants can add their message of hope or reconciliation. There will also be several commissioned artists creating pieces during the Expo that aim to capture the energy and experience of the Walk for Reconciliation.

Commitment Gallery

10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Using the pre-existing infrastructure of the tennis court in Strathcona Park, Reconciliation Canada will facilitate the creation of a temporary Commitment Gallery. This will serve as an opportunity for participants to make a personal pledge towards reconciliation following their participation in the Walk. Commitment Cards will be exhibited on the fence to visually display and celebrate actions that extend beyond the scope of the Walk.

Backgrounder: Reconciliation Canada



Born from the vision of Chief Robert Joseph, Gwawaenuk Elder, Reconciliation Canada is an Indigenous-led charitable organization that acts as a catalyst for positive social change and a leading voice for reconciliation in the country. As a non-partisan organization, Reconciliation Canada mobilizes the growing reconciliation movement by building national awareness, inspiring meaningful dialogue and facilitating transformative experiences that revitalize relationships among Indigenous peoples and all Canadians.

Reconciliation Canada is continuously advancing the reconciliation movement with its national initiatives, notably by hosting the Walk for Reconciliation in partnership with the City of Vancouver on September 24th, 2017. In 2013, Reconciliation Canada hosted the first Walk for Reconciliation of its kind, which brought 70,000 people together in the Vancouver area. Past initiatives include: co-hosting events to coincide with the closing of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada in 2015, including the Walk for Reconciliation in Ottawa that brought 10,000 individuals together, and bringing together leaders in six National Reconciliation Gatherings across the country.

The Walk for Reconciliation in 2017 is part of Reconciliation Canada's *Reconciliation in Action: A National Engagement Strategy* is a *Canada 150 Signature Project*, a two-year initiative with the goal of examining and documenting perceptions, actions and aspirations of Canadians in relation to reconciliation. This narrative acknowledges our common history, highlights current achievements and creates a vision for the future. This project includes several initiatives implemented across Canada including:

- The Walk for Reconciliation
- National Reconciliation Gatherings
- o National Narrative on Reconciliation Online Engagement
- o In the Spirit of Reconciliation: An Intergeneration Gathering
- o National Narrative Report on Reconciliation
- National Thought Table on Reconciliation

Reconciliation Canada's core activities also include Reconciliation Dialogue Workshops and Speaking Engagements. These workshops and engagements bring community leaders together to build meaningful partnerships and identify opportunities for collaboration. Each workshop creates a safe space for participants to share personal stories, discuss visions for a better future, and to develop individual and collective action plans. Additionally, Reconciliation Canada's speaking engagements and interactive outreach activities promote an understanding of shared histories and building a new way forward. Other initiatives have included work in the areas of reconciliation leadership and economic reconciliation.

Reconciliation Canada continues to build and maintain a national dialogue on reconciliation and to catalyze action with the vision of achieving a vibrant Canada and shared prosperity for all peoples.

Fast Facts and Figures

- Reconciliation Canada began in September 2012 with a bold vision to promote reconciliation by engaging Canadians in meaningful dialogue, which is crucial to revitalize relationships between Indigenous peoples and all Canadians. This vision was originally held by Reconciliation Canada's Ambassador, Chief Robert Joseph.
- In November 2012, Reconciliation Canada hosted its very first workshop, a gathering of multi-cultural Elders, to set the foundation for its work moving forward. For two days, Elders from Indigenous and other ancient histories gathered to explore how reconciliation, as a way of being, can help our society move forward.

- On September 22, 2013, the first Walk for Reconciliation was held in downtown Vancouver. 70,000 people braved the pouring rain to show their support for and commitment to reconciliation.
- In May 2015, the second Walk for Reconciliation was held in Ottawa to coincide with the closing of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC). 10,000 people made the walk from Gatineau to Ottawa.
- Reconciliation Canada has conducted over 100 Dialogue Workshops in communities across Canada, including Vancouver, Victoria, Calgary, Edmonton, Fort McMurray and Whitehorse.

Ambassador: Chief Robert Joseph

Chief Joseph is currently the Ambassador for Reconciliation Canada and a member of the National Assembly of First Nations Elders Council. He was formerly the Executive Director of the Indian Residential School Survivors Society and is an honourary witness to Canada's Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC). As Chairman of the Native American Leadership Alliance for Peace and Reconciliation and Ambassador for Peace and Reconciliation with the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace (IFWP), Chief Joseph has sat with the leaders of South Africa, Israel, Japan, South Korea, Mongolia and Washington, DC to learn from and share his understanding of faith, hope, healing and reconciliation.

#### Fifty thousand people gathered at the 2017 Vancouver Walk for Reconciliation, in the spirit of IWe are all one

Vancouver, BC – On Sunday September 24, 2017, 50,000 people of all backgrounds gathered Downtown Vancouver to take a step on the road to reconciliation. Participants gathered on Georgia Street from Seymour to Cambie and adjacent streets. The procession went over the viaduct and ended at Strathcona Park.

Born from the vision of Chief Robert Joseph, Ambassador of Reconciliation Canada, the walk was as a call to action, inspiring all Canadians and Indigenous Peoples across Canada to make a shared commitment towards reconciliation and revitalized relationships among Indigenous peoples and all Canadians.

The Walk for Reconciliation is a Canada 150+ Signature Event, and was delivered in partnership between the City of Vancouver, Reconciliation Canada, the Government of Canada, and Vancouver Parks Board. Canada 150+ is grounded in community consultation, direction from Vancouver's Urban Aboriginal Peoples Advisory Committee (UAPAC), and close collaboration with Vancouver's three Host Nations: Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh First Nations.

The walk finished with a Reconciliation Expo, held at Strathcona Park. Participants heard from twelve speakers including an inspiring keynote speech. The artistic program included five musicians from across the country and eight culturally diverse dance groups, highlighting the unique contributions of people from all backgrounds to reconciliation in Canada. Activities and exhibits included the Right to Play children's area, lacrosse demos, a life size replica of Carey Newman's Witness Blanket, the KAIROS Blanket Exercise, the National Centre for Truth and Reconciliation display and on-site painting with Vancouver Mural Festival.

Staff looked into the email and a few issues came to light:

- The invite that came from Village & Co was not intended to be an invite from the City to elected officials and was sent to their own in house list and without our knowledge. City staff are speaking to Village & Co with strict instruction about using our name and sending correspondence without our approval.
- Heritage Canada was responsible for the federal invitations. Staff are reviewing the protocol with them as it sounds like there may have been some issues with them not sending invites if the one from was the only one you received
- Moving forward, I am working to determine how Heritage Canada/city staff want to handle invitations moving forward. It sounds like having the federal government do it may not be the best approach based on this experience

In terms of having Minister Wilson-Raybould involved in some of the dialogue session, let me know if that is of interest and I can talk to staff about what the next steps are.

### How Indigenous people are rebranding Canada 150

The Canada 150 birthday celebrations could stand to be more inclusive of the Aboriginal experience. Vancouver is trying to make that happen.

Believe it or not, Indigenous people are responsible for salvaging Vancouver's sesquicentennial bash. For a time, the city considered boycotting Canada 150. Two years ago, when Ottawa put the squeeze on the city to sign on to the grand jubilee, city staff registered serious discomfort. Exalting Canada's colonial past two years after the Truth and Reconciliation Commission delivered its calls to action seemed regressive, and potentially harmful to the city's new relationship with local First Nations. Vancouver had recently designated itself a "City of Reconciliation," 70,000 had marched in support of rapprochement and Deputy Mayor Andrea Reimer was learning Squamish. Staff came to her proposing the opt-out.

Reimer wasn't opposed, but wanted input from the city's Urban Aboriginal Peoples Advisory Committee first, she says. The nine-member panel, which advises city council on how to better include Indigenous people and perspectives in city life, came back with a different idea—one council unanimously approved: Why not celebrate the city's Indigenous history and culture instead?

So Vancouver, whose Indigenous population of 53,000 ranks third-highest among Canadian metropolises—after Winnipeg (78,000) and Edmonton (62,000)—is doing just that, with a \$7-million event it's calling Canada 150+. The plus symbol—another Advisory Committee suggestion—was added partly to counter the enduring myth that Canada prior to contact was empty and in need of civilization.

So, far from being another hurrah for Canada, the event is deliberately challenging our collective amnesia. And it's receiving federal funding to do so (costs are being split between the municipal and federal governments, as in other cities).

Canada 150+ launches in English Bay on July 19 with a traditional canoe welcome, followed by a nine-day arts festival in Vancouver's downtown. Nightly headliners include acts like Cree icon Buffy Sainte-Marie, but the focus is the history and culture of the Musqueam, Squamish and Tsleil-Waututh, the three Coast Salish nations on whose unceded territories Vancouver is built.

They have been here longer than the English have been in England. Their culture was thriving when Dublin belonged to the Vikings and Sicily was ruled by Muslims.

"We are taking a huge risk—we don't know how the public is going to react," says Ginger Gosnell-Myers, the city's first manager of Aboriginal relations. She is Nisga'a and Kwakwaka'wakw, a cousin of another Kwakwaka'wakw powerhouse, Justice Minister Jody Wilson-Raybould. Reimer, for her part, doesn't seem to much care whether the event sparks controversy.

Whether or not you have the compassion-based belief that Canada has a moral responsibility to change, she says, it's clear the traumas of the past are crippling the present, financially and otherwise.

"We need to start doing things differently." And after all, Gosnell-Myers adds: "None of us is going anywhere. We have to learn to live together—in a respectful way, and in a truthful way."

Underlying the work of the most expensive reconciliation project the city has ever undertaken is a multi-year attempt to re-root Vancouver in the culture of its earliest inhabitants.

The next step, a process that could see key place names replaced with Indigenous ones, is potentially more controversial. "Bridges, streets and buildings" are all open to consideration, Reimer says. Emotions will run high, but many believe it's time.

Vancouver sits near the heart of Canada's pre-contact capital. By the 18th century, twice as many lived in thriving, well-fortified villages of fishers, tanners, potters and toy-makers surrounding the Georgia Strait as in the rest of Canada combined (more, even, than in New York).

But while some 200 B.C. place names commemorate the voyages of Captains Cook and Vancouver, who arrived toward the end of that century, there isn't even a plaque to commemorate a smallpox plague that wiped out all but 10 per cent of B.C.'s Indigenous inhabitants—arguably the most significant event in the province's history.

No surprise, then, that Canada 150 is spurring a creative outpouring among Indigenous artists to shine light on some of these painful chapters. "Remember, Resist, Redraw," a cross-country poster project led by the Graphic History Collective, is putting an Indigenous lens on key events in Canadian history.

#Resist150, a multimedia project led by Metis artist Christi Belcourt, features poems, shared histories and other "acts of resistance," like the 150 traditional tattoos Belcourt is aiming to ink over the coming year. And the year's most talked-about art exhibit, Kent Monkman's Shame and Prejudice: A Story of Resilience, which opened last month in Toronto, uses the sesquicentennial to ridicule and expand Canada's rigid, national narrative. Monkman, a Winnipeg-raised Cree artist, reimagines the grand chronicle, sometimes by inserting his flamboyant, drag queen alter ego, Miss Chief Eagle Testickle. You'll find Miss Chief, lover of Louis Vuitton and pink heels, in, for example, a cheeky send-up of Robert Harris's famed portrait of the Fathers of Confederation. She's nude, seated facing them, her legs akimbo. The men look on in horror, and in lust. He called it The Daddies.

It's not all fun and transgression, though. In The Scream, a visceral comment on residential schools, Mounties and Grey Nuns tear Indigenous children from their mothers' arms. Five spectacularly large oil portraits depict all the ways Winnipeg's colonial history is infecting its future—the racism, violence, alcohol, despair. To Monkman, apparently, the sesquicentennial is synonymous with all that has been lost.

But his art—gratifyingly—is no longer truly subversive. A truer, less simplistic Canadian narrative is finally starting to emerge. It rejects the idea of 1867 as a starting point, acknowledges the country's many sins and returns the Indigenous perspective to where it belongs: front and centre, as the best and most enduring part of the Canadian story—a tale that stretches back not 150 years, but 12,000. That's the version Vancouver is hoping to tell.
