I am responding to your request of August 13, 2019 under the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* for:

Records of applications for business licenses which were declined by the City specifically due to the fact that the applicant's business offered LGBTQ "conversion therapy" or "reparative therapy", including records indicating why businesses licenses were declined in such cases (e.g. statements of final decisions, communications etc.), from January 1, 2018 to August 1, 2019.

We have completed the search for responsive records for this request and no responsive records have been located.

Please note, the Deputy Chief Licence Inspector has confirmed there have been no license applications received for this type of business.
