

1. This location a block away from Jones Park, 2 blocks away from Tecumseh elementary on the south and 3 blocks away from Cunningham to the east, and two storefronts from Penpals Montessori.

s.22(1) from the new proposed medical marijuana store at 5403 Victoria Drive and I own a s.22(1) s.22(1). I am very concerned that this store will affect businesses, neighbors and the atmosphere of this neighborhood.

There are already at least 3 medical marijuana stores on Victoria Drive between Kingsway (30th Avenue and Victoria Drive) and 49th Avenue. That is a lot of retail cannabis stores in a few blocks.

The store plans on being open from 12-6 Tuesday to Saturday. This will be very disruptive to people who live and work in the neighborhood. The medical marijuana stores create their own environment of people loitering, congregating, and making noise well into the evening hours. There is the issue of their customers ingesting or smoking the marijuana products once they have it. This new proposed dispensary is on a corner so the lane is right there. Additionally, the smell from these stores is very pungent, so strong that when I drive by the stores I can smell it from my car. There has also been 2 instances that I know of where the stores were robbed and created a lot of fear in the neighborhood.

I'm also concerned with the parking. The parking in the area is already extremely tight for our s.22(1) who are s.22(1). This would be a deterrent to our s.22(1) if they couldn't find a spot.)

Finally, there are 3 elementary schools close by. These schools regularly walk the children by this store on the way to the high school at Gladstone and 27th Avenue or to the park at 38th and Victoria Drive, just down the street. This proposed store is too close to these schools and the park. There are also s.22(1) that have families with small children.

I do not want another medical marijuana store in the neighborhood.

Please take these items into consideration when you decide if this location should be approved for a medical marijuana store.

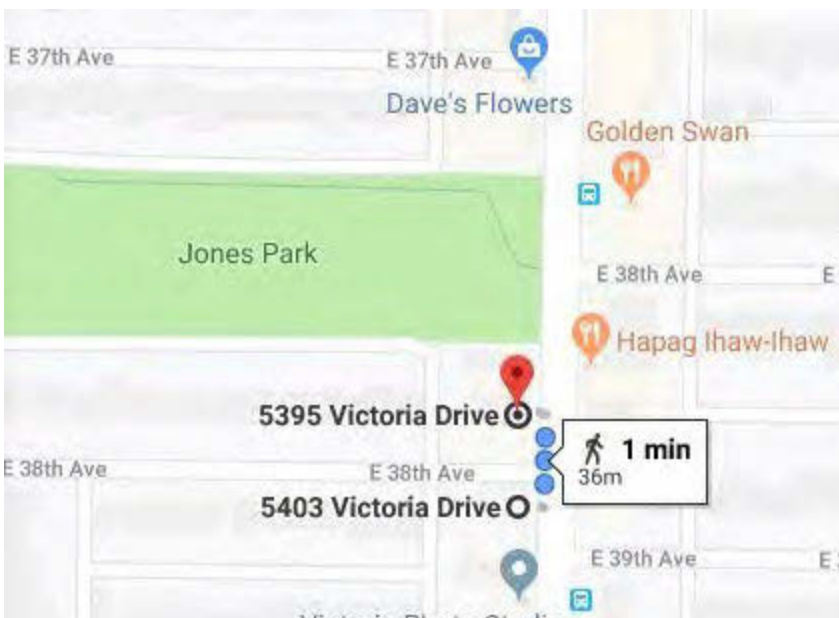

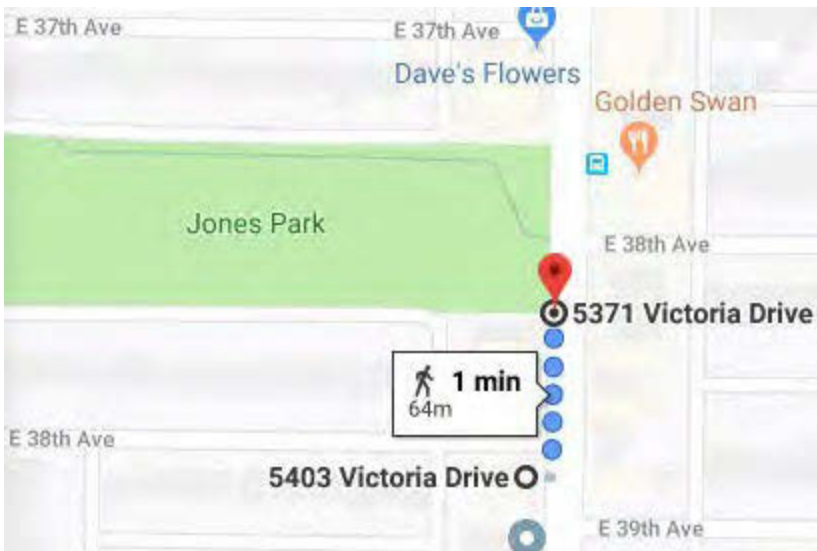
Here is why we are opposed:

1) There is a preschool and after school tutoring services nearby called Penpals Montessori Children's House. We are very concerned that children and youth walking to and from the school will be exposed to or be influenced by cannabis. The City of Vancouver's zoning requirements indicate that a Retail Dealer - Cannabis must be at least 300 m from schools. 5403 Victoria Drive is approximately only **36 m away from Penpals Montessori Children's House**.



Penpals Montessori Children's House is a school catering to children ages 2.5 to 6 years old. They operate on a Monday to Friday schedule with both morning and afternoon classes starting at 8:30 am and ending at 3:45pm. s.22(1) Here's a link to the school's website for more information: <http://www.penpalsmontessori.ca/>. I also understand that this school offers after-school tutoring services for older students (elementary school-aged) which I believe commences around 4pm, when the afternoon school sessions end at 3:45 pm.

2) There is a park with a playground nearby named Jones Park. We are very concerned that children and youth walking to and from the park and playground will be exposed to or be influenced by cannabis. 5403 Victoria Drive is approximately only **64 m away from Jones Park**.

We are writing as local resident to object strongly to the above application on the following grounds.

There are child day care facilities (Penpals Montessori Children's house, address: 5395 Victoria Dr.) and a playground in the area (Jones Park) which children and families use on a constant basis including an elementary school in close proximity to the proposed address. In addition, children from pre-school frequently go on walks in the area with their guardians.

Potential increase in criminal activity related to the high-profile nature of marijuana stores in the following ways. Violent crimes, loitering, break and entering which would have a significant impact on families and vulnerable sector residents, seniors and children.

Increased garbage and waste discarding in the area with the potential to reduce property values.

Potential of high potency narcotics and increase in overdoses due to increased influx of marginalized groups. Negative impact to community morale and efforts for proactive community policing to create a safer area for families.

The use and consumption of marijuana whether to medical rationale or not is a gateway drug for many people in this community who are already marginalized. The negative optics of such a storefront creates additional risk to young children who may be in proximity or passing by thus placing them at the highest risk.

Finally, the increased availability promotes usage among vulnerable sector groups, or those impact by addiction in the area attempting to recover

We wanted to reach out to you regarding the development application notice that we received in our mailbox this week. The application notice is DP-2019-00452.

As long time residents of the area, we would really like to offer our two cents to deny having a cannabis store in our immediate neighbourhood. We live s.22(1) We feel as though having another cannabis shop on Victoria Drive is just too much. With what we describe below, we hope that you will reconsider this application. We feel as though it will only add to the ever changing community in a negative way. There is already one cannabis shop down the street, closer to East 33rd Avenue - isn't that enough?

Over the years, we have watched our neighbourhood go through multiple changes; mostly demographically. We used to know all of our neighbours and we all helped each other out and now we are lucky if we know the people driving down our street. On our one block, we have multiple rentals homes now and all of the rental homes seem to contain multiple suites, in addition to one house where a whole group of people live. The rest of the residents are either elderly (babysitting their grandchildren) or handicapped in some way.

Storefronts have transformed into shabby business fronts and with the rise of housing costs, we find our community filling with more homeless people and more drug use. As s.22(1) forms a T behind the fire hall, we see drug deals often. We often think twice before going for a walk in Jones Park as there are people doing drugs or sleeping on the benches there. s.22(1) and we are constantly witnessing people from trying to break into garages, peering into neighbourhood homes and steal food out of our gardens. Yes, we call the police and the city but feel as though we are becoming "that house" - we aren't complainers, just frustrated citizens. We are grateful for the community policing station on Victoria/39th but they too have said that the neighbourhood is changing.

We understand that the price of living has skyrocketed and we appreciate the need for densification but with having more people move into the area, the rate of crime has increased, the garbage on our streets and boulevards is terrible, people aren't picking up pet waste and there is already a lack of parking. Whenever we walk our dog, we take a garbage bag with us and fill it! With our home being in an area with deep lots and alleys, 4 lane-way houses have popped up within the last 2 years. The alley has **cracked severely** from heavy machinery and work trucks, cars are racing up and down our alley, twice almost taking out s.22(1) and questionable people are cutting through the alleys. One house s.22(1) They have been building a lane way house for almost a year. Their front yard and boulevard has been torn up, they don't cut their lawn and it's bringing our whole block down. They just don't care about the neighbourhood. The restaurant on the s.22(1) doesn't have enough parking for their establishment so people park in front of our homes, even though there are residential parking signs there. We have tried to encourage our neighbours to sign off on getting permit parking in our area a few times but the majority of them do not speak english or are elderly and are afraid to get involved - it's terrible.
