I am responding to your request of October 17, 2019 for:

In relation to Mayor Stewart's Statement released on October 16, 2019 titled "Kennedy Stewart on Federal Election: Andrew Scheer would be worse than Stephen Harper":

- 1. Any and all emails, notes, telephone notes, meeting notes, reports or advice, or other correspondence between i) City staff and the Mayor and/or ii) Mayor's office related to the statement and the related press conference with the media on October 16, 2019.**
- 2. Any notes or other correspondence related to the Mayor, the Mayor's staff, or City's staff making "repeated invitations and even conversations with key Conservatives" and Andrew Scheer as per the Mayor's statement.**

From September 1, 2019 to October 31, 2019.
