I am very happy to announce that after being vacant for the last few years, I am filling the second Deputy City Manager position in the City Manager's office. This person will be working with me, Paul, the City Leadership Team and departmental staff to drive transformation initiatives to enhance the City's service delivery and cost-effectiveness, and in creating new revenue sources for the City. Council has made it clear that we need to find further efficiencies and this position will lead that work.

As you know, EY was recently engaged by the City to recommend a set of focus areas for modernization and efficiencies, in the context of the increasing growth and complexity faced by the City.
